# ISABELLA AND REDWOOD SPARK NORTH TO VICTORY

DAYTON, Ohio -- Mayfield's Andy Isabella provided the offensive firepower, while Midview's Dante Redwood came up with some well-timed defense Saturday to lead the Division I-III North squad to a 24-14 win in the Ohio North-South Classic at Welcome Stadium.

Isabella, a Massachusetts signee, caught three passes for 115 yards and two touchdowns in earning offensive most valuable player honors for the North.

Redwood, who was pressed into duty at cornerback after an injury sidelined Mentor's Marc Walton, delivered an interception, three tackles and a pass break-up. His recovery in the end zone of a South fumbled punt forced by Bedford's London Cloud provided the North with a comfortable lead late in the game.

Isabella turned a wobbly first-quarter pass from Hudson quarterback Mitch Guadagni into a 67-yard catch-and-run to open the first quarter scoring. He later got behind the South defense as Mentor QB Jake Floriea stepped up in the pocket and found him for a 33-yard score.

That staked the North to a 14-point lead it would hold until the final seconds of the first half when South QB Nathan Densel of Dublin Scioto hit Kyle Marcinick of Dublin Coffman for a 13-yard touchdown.

"I just went out there and did my thing," Isabella said. "The quarterbacks both did a great job of getting me the ball."

The first half of the game was marred by a total of 10 personal foul and unsportsmanlike conduct penalties against both sides. The chippy play started at kickoff and players from both sides were flagged for jawing at one another.

In the center of it all was Canton McKinley wide receiver/defensive back Eric Glover-Williams, who at one point was ejected from the game by officials, but re-entered the contest late in the second quarter and was allowed to continue playing.

Glover-Williams, an Ohio State signee, played the part of an emotional leader for the North throughout the game. His future Buckeyes teammate, Rashod Berry of Lorain, said he was not about to stifle the exuberant Glover-Williams.

"Whatever he does is best for him," Berry said. "If it works for him, I want him to keep doing it."

Redwood made his presence on defense felt in the second half when he intercepted Worthington Kilbourne's Griffin Dahn. He said Bedford coach Sean Williams had him ready for the South to target him following Walton's injury.

"He (Williams) told me inside leverage," Redwood said. "I knew the guy was going to do a hitch-and-go. I just read it and made the play."

Cloud finished with nine tackles, a fumble recovery and a big forced fumble in the second half. He said a lot of the North-South tension had been building up over the last several weeks.

"Everybody's been waiting all week, all month to get to this game," Cloud said. "There was a lot of built up energy and people just wanted to hit people. It was fun."
